



Fire Fighting Operations For Fire Industry Professionals



The Institution of Fire Engineers will be hosting a one-day live fire programme for fire engineers and people who work in fire related industries, or who have an interest in the fire safety design of buildings. This programme has been developed to give participants the opportunity to gain a better understanding of fire and smoke behaviour, as well as relevant fire fighting techniques by involving them in a series of real fire simulations.

All participants will be able to gain first hand experience of real fires in building enclosures, including fire initiation and development, fire and smoke spread, flashover, the use of fire fighting equipment, fire fighting and search and rescue techniques and more. The programme will be conducted by experienced professional fire officers, using various enclosures, props and scenarios, and has been designed to offer participants an experience that is as close to the real thing as possible.
